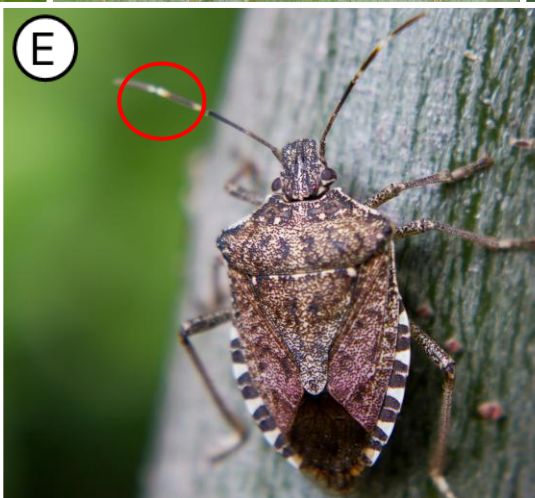
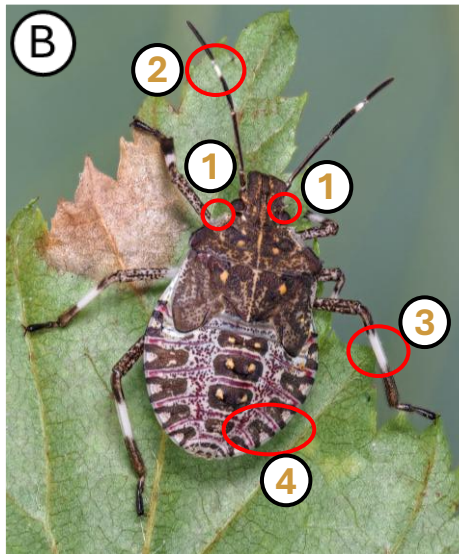
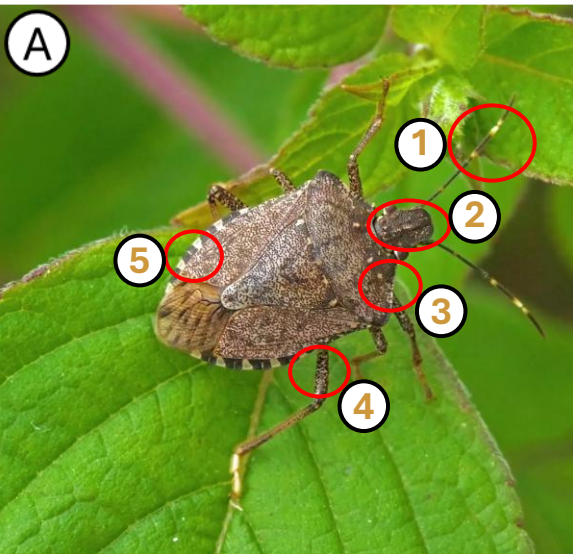


BROWN MARMORATED STINK BUG

Known hosts: Highly polyphagous, incl. fruit trees, field crops, vegetables.
Distribution: Cosmopolitan, not in SA.

- (A)** Adults. **1:** banded antennae; **2:** blunt mouth ; **3:** smooth shoulder edge ; **4:** mottled legs ; **5:** banded abdominal edge
- (B)** Mature nymph. **1:** Spines in front of eyes and on shoulder edges; **2:** banded antennae; ; **3:** banded legs ; **4:** rust coloured abdomen with broad brown markings.
- (C)** Eggs & 1st instars. Note the yellow abdomens of nymphs.
- (D)** 3rd instar nymph.
- (E)** Adult male with mottled legs and more subtle leg bands.
- (F)** BMSB look-alike. Note lack of banded antennae.
